That the Southern Nevada District Board of Health approve the attached Amendment No. 1 between Clark County, Nevada on behalf of Clark County Family Services and the Southern Nevada Health District for Public Health Nurse Liaison Services for the period from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2028.

DISCUSSION:

The amendment to the interlocal agreement allows the District to continue providing Public Health Nurse Liaison services for Clark County Family Services. The Nurse Liaison provides nursing consultation and guidance for Clark County Family Services' Four and Under Team. Children referred to the Four and Under Team are medically fragile or have parents with psychiatric or severe emotional problems that impair their ability to guarantee their children's safety. The Nurse Liaison carries a nursing caseload of medically fragile, at-risk children and their families referred to the Four and Under Team. This position also provides nursing consultation to other Clark County Family Services' teams as requested. The Nurse Liaison provides guidance to Health District team members regarding Clark County Family Services. The budget period is from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2028.

Funding

The funding for this agreement of \$162,156.80 for two year period was made available to the Southern Nevada Health District from Clark County, Nevada on behalf of Clark County Family Services. This funding will cover the following for the Public Health Nurse Liaison: salary.

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
CBE NO. 605996-21
PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE LIAISON SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2026, by and between CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA (hereinafter referred to as “COUNTY”), and SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as “AGENCY”).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the parties entered into an agreement under CBE Number 605996-21, entitled “Public Health Nurse Liaison Services” dated March 1, 2022 (hereinafter referred to as AGREEMENT); and

WHEREAS the parties desire to amend the AGREEMENT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the AGREEMENT as follows:

1. ARTICLE II: TERM OF AGREEMENT, 1ST PARAGRAPH

ORIGINALLY READ

The term of this AGREEMENT shall be from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Thereafter, unless terminated pursuant to the provisions contained herein, the term of AGREEMENT will automatically renew for a one (1) year term, not to exceed five (5) years from the date of execution.

REVISED TO READ

The term of this AGREEMENT shall be from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Thereafter, unless terminated pursuant to the provisions contained herein, the term of AGREEMENT will automatically renew for a one (1) year term, not to exceed seven (7) years from the date of execution.

2. The revisions contained herein are effective as of June 30, 2026.

This Amendment No. 1 represents an increase of \$162,156.80.

Except as expressly amended herein, the terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect.
