This includes anyone who has experienced an overdose and those impacted such as loved ones and friends.

OUR GOAL

Our goal is to help people reduce overdose risk and the trauma's experienced by an overdose through support, education, and resource referrals based on individual readiness.

SERVICES

SPORT can assist with linkage to community services based on identified need and readiness. These services can include evidence-based care, overdose prevention education, and follow up from our team to ensure successful outcomes.
