

Three reasons to get the COVID-19 booster



It's safe.

The FDA only releases COVID-19 vaccines / boosters and authorizes their use to the public when there is enough data proving they are safe and meet or exceed efficacy thresholds.



It's up to date.

Over time, you might have less protection against COVID-19. Data shows boosters are the most effective at preventing severe illness, hospitalizations and death from variants of COVID-19 currently circulating, including the Omicron variant.



It's free.

COVID-19 boosters administered by the Southern Nevada Health District are provided at no-cost to you. If you have insurance, they may be billed an administration fee. You will not be charged a co-pay and will not receive a bill from the Health District for the COVID-19 boosters.

After receiving the vaccine and boosters, it is recommended that you still take other preventive measures. These include wearing a mask in public indoor places when disease transmission is high, social distancing, frequent handwashing, and other hygiene practices.
