

Final Guidance for Facilities

As of June 1, 2021, facilities are able to return to pre-pandemic operations regarding occupancy restrictions and additional disinfection requirements of surfaces.

The following will govern the use of masks or face coverings:

- Fully vaccinated people do not need to wear a mask or practice social distancing in public areas except where required by federal, state, or local laws or regulations.
- Masks are required to be worn on public transportation. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention continues to recommend masks be worn in health care facilities. State of Nevada Child Care Licensing continues to require masks be worn in child care facilities.

Facilities still need to meet any workplace requirements set forth by Nevada OSHA.

Nothing in this guidance prohibits a facility from being more stringent in implementing various COVID-19 measures that include requiring patrons to provide proof of vaccination, practice social distancing or wear a face covering.

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
