



COVID-19 Vaccine Snapshot

Clark County, Nevada

General Notes: This snapshot provides data managed by the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public and Behavioral Health, Immunization Program for Clark County, NV, and assessed by the Southern Nevada Health District's Office of Epidemiology and Disease Surveillance. Due to delays in processing and reporting, data from the most recent date are less complete than data from older dates. For the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, initiation equates to completion. Population estimates are calculated using U.S. Census Bureau; American Community Survey, 2019 American Community Survey 5-year estimates for Clark County. Population data is based on estimates and do not include transient individuals; consequently, the percentage of the population that is vaccinated is an approximation. Race is based upon self-identification and individuals who identify as Hispanic may be of any race. The COVID-19 vaccines are not currently authorized for persons under the age of 12 years (Pfizer) or under the age of 18 (Moderna, Johnson & Johnson). Data for the total numbers of vaccines administered in Clark County includes total doses reported by the Veterans Affairs (VA). The VA provides data weekly. **Data is considered preliminary and subject to change.** Data was last received on 05/19/2021.

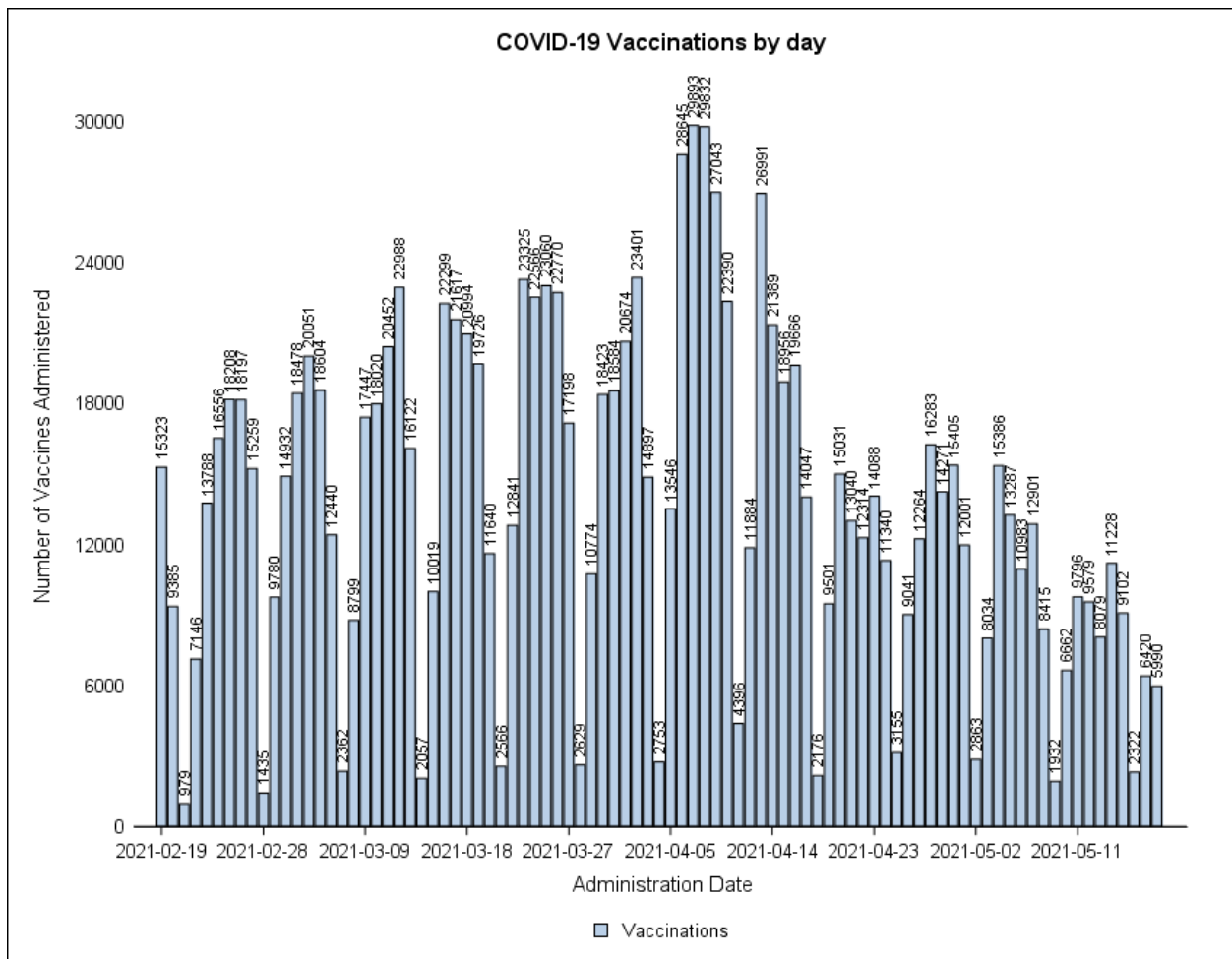

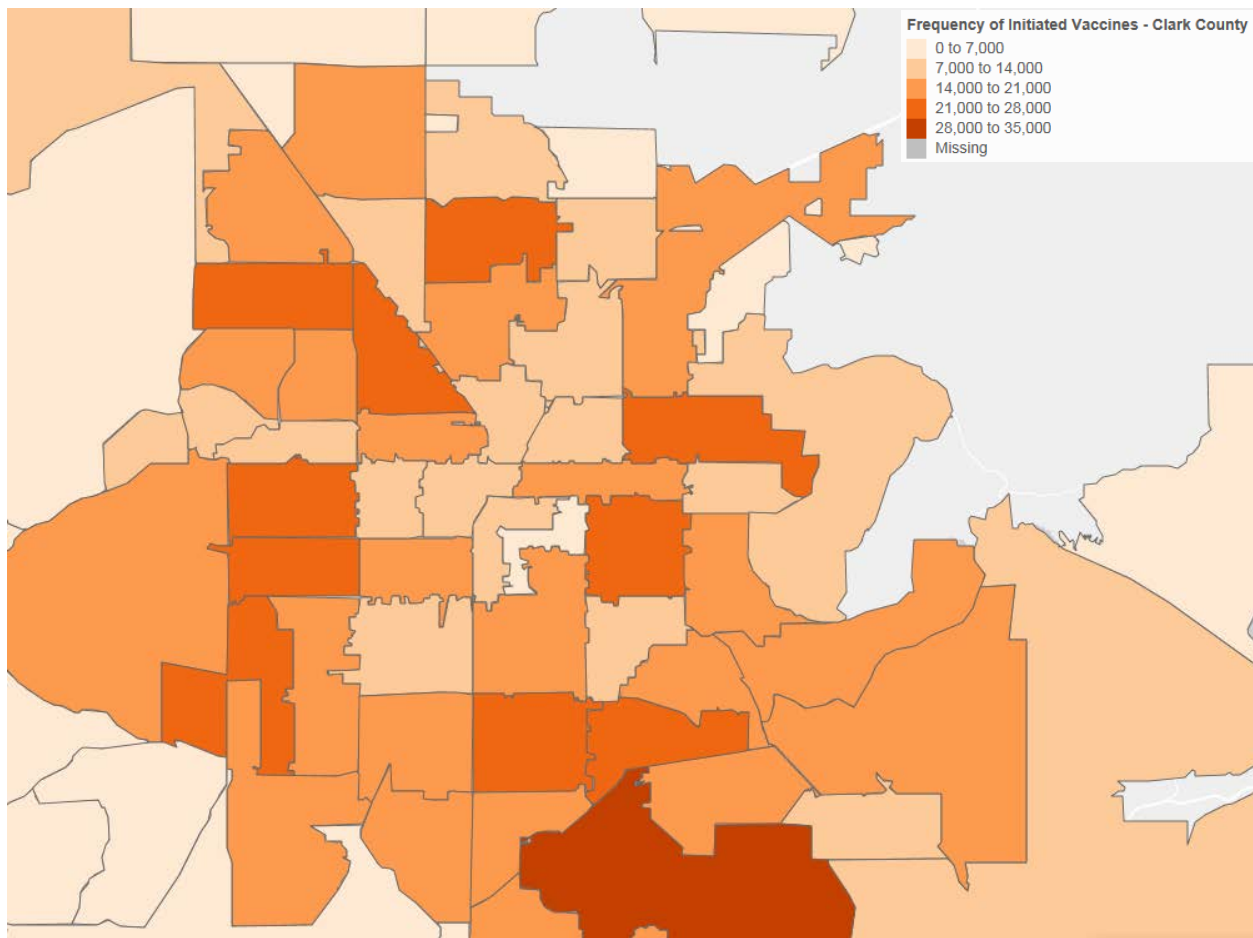
