A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR HEARING OFFICER MEETINGS

B. NOTICES OF VIOLATION WITH CONTESTED FACTS:

 Christine K. Mault – NOV #SW25-178/C6- For 1) operating a disposal site in Clark County, Nevada, without a permit issued by the Solid Waste Management Authority on or about August 31, 2024; and 2) placing, depositing or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon the vacant parcel located at the southwest corner of West Mountains Edge Parkway and South Fort Apache Road, Clark County, Nevada on or about August 31, 2024.

SNHD and the respondent reached a compromised settlement of the case. The details of the agreement were stated on the record and approved and ordered by Hearing Officer Melton. Hearing officer found Christine K. Mault in violation of 2) and imposed an administrative penalty of \$500. A Cease and Desist order is issued to stop placing, depositing, or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon property other than property designated or set aside for such purpose. Failure to comply will result in the original penalty of \$2,000 as initially sought in the Notice of Violation.

C. NON-CONTESTED NOTICES OF VIOLATION:

1. Endurance Environmental Solutions, LLC – NOV #SW25-236/C4- For 1) operating a disposal site in Clark County, Nevada, without a permit issued by the solid waste management authority on or about September 23, 2024; and 2) placing, depositing or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon the properties located at and adjacent to the I-15 northbound Public Right-of-Way between East Cheyenne Avenue and North Lamb Boulevard, North Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada on or about September 23, 2024.

The respondent did not contest the Notice of Violation, agreeing to the facts alleged and accepting the proposed penalty. Hearing Officer Melton found Endurance Environmental Solutions, LLC in violation of 1) and 2), and imposed an administrative penalty of \$2,000 for each violation for a total administrative penalty of \$4,000. A Cease and Desist order is issued to stop operating a solid waste disposal site without a permit issued by the Solid Waste Management Authority at this location or anywhere else in Clark County, Nevada. A Cease and Desist order is issued to stop placing, depositing, or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon property other than property designated or set aside for such purpose.

 Wen Hui Li – NOV #SW25-245/C6- For 1) operating a disposal site in Clark County, Nevada, without a permit issued by the solid waste management authority on or about October 2, 2024; and 2) placing, depositing or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon the vacant parcel located southwest of South Lindell Road and West Ponderosa Way, Clark County, Nevada on or about October 2, 2024.

SNHD and the respondent reached a compromised settlement of the case. The details of the agreement were stated on the record and approved and ordered by Hearing Officer Melton. Hearing officer found Wen Hui Li in violation of 2) and imposed an administrative penalty of \$500. A Cease and Desist order is issued to stop placing, depositing or dumping or causing to be placed, deposited or dumped solid waste upon property other than property designated or set aside for such purpose. Failure to comply will result in the original penalty of \$2,000 as initially sought in the Notice of Violation.
