That the Southern Nevada District Board of Health approve an amendment to the Interlocal Contract between the Southern Nevada Health District and the Clark County School District (CCSD) to provide services to support the Southern Nevada Partnerships to Improve Community Health (PICH) Year 3 grant awarded to the Southern Nevada Health District by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) (award #NU58DP005705-03)

# **DISCUSSION**:

The Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) received a three-year (September 30, 2014 – September 29, 2017) PICH grant award from CDC. On September 2, 2017, SNHD received a Notice of Award authorizing expenditure of Year 3 funds. The CCSD will use the funding included in the Year 3 contract amendment to support and promote physical activity by increasing access to opportunities for physical activity among students.

# **FUNDING:**

The Year 3 PICH funding included in this contract amendment totals \$290,213. The associated Scope of Work will be completed between September 30, 2016 and September 29, 2017.



# AMENDMENT A03 TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT AND CLARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT SNHD-6-PICH-INT-15-026

WITH REFERENCE to Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") SNHD-6-PICH-INT-15-026, effective January 22, 2015 as amended November 30, 2015 and August 1, 2016, between the Southern Nevada Health District ("Health District") and the Clark County School District ("Contractor") (individually referred to as "Party" and collectively as "Parties").

WHEREAS, additional funding from the PICH grant, 5NU58DP005705-03-00, is being added to this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to amend said Agreement as follows:

A. The fourth paragraph on page one is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following paragraph:

WHEREAS, Health District is the recipient of grant funding received from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Department of Health and Human Services, CFDA 93.331, a) Grant Award 1U58DP005705-01, titled Southern Nevada Partnership to Improve Community Health ("PICH") award date of September 17, 2014, b) Grant Award 6NU58DP005705-02-01 award date of September 28, 2015 and c) Grant Award 5NU58DP005705-03-00 award date of August 25, 2016; through which Contractor, as the subrecipient, will enhance its physical activity and education program.

- B. Numbered Paragraph 1 is revised by extending the end date of the Agreement from September 29, 2016 to September 29, 2017.
- C. Numbered Paragraph 3, Compensation, is replaced in its entirety as follows:

<u>COMPENSATION</u>. Contractor shall complete the services in a timely manner and consistent with the Scope of Work outlined in Attachment A-A03, attached hereto. Contractor will be reimbursed by the Health District for expenses incurred by the Contractor as provided in Attachment B-A03: Payment. The total not-to-exceed amount of this Agreement is \$1,064,083.29. This project is supported by the federal PICH grant



described on page 1 of this Agreement in the amount of \$1,064,083.29, which accounts for 100% of the total funding of this contract.

- C. Attachment A-A02 Scope of Work has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Attachment A-A03 Scope of Work.
- G. Attachment B-A02 Payment has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Attachment B-A03 Payment.

This Amendment shall be effective from the last signature affixed to this Amendment.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.

#### ATTACHMENT A-A03 SCOPE OF WORK

#### Period of Performance: January 22, 2015 - September 29, 2015

- 1. Contractor will work to increase by 37 the number of Clark County School District schools that are enhancing physical education courses and offering additional before and after school physical activities opportunities over the project period.
- 2. Contractor's responsibilities and specific Year 1 deliverables include:
  - i) Expand the CrossFit (CF) or CrossFit Kids (CFK) program to 17 new elementary, middle or high schools.
  - ii) Provide support to the 11 existing CF high schools.
  - iii) Train 25 teachers in CF and 25 in CFK certification (teachers for Year 1 and Year 2 implementation). Two sites have existing teachers certified; one site has a teacher that teaches both middle and high school students.
  - iv) Purchase instructional supplies to support program expansion.
  - v) Provide professional development training for 35 CF certified teachers (25 new plus 10 from original CF sites).
  - vi) Provide professional development training on incorporating activity breaks for 400 teachers.
  - vii) Implement before or after school CF programs in 25 schools (15 new plus 10 original).
  - viii) Conduct Family Functional Fitness Night events at 25 schools (15 new plus 10 original).
  - ix) Conduct 1 CF Showcase event.
  - x) Develop and disseminate guidance binders to support Wellness Regulation.
  - xi) Collaborate with Health District staff and project evaluators to develop an evaluation plan for project activities and collect and report necessary data.
  - xii) Attend required meetings and maintain involvement in related coalitions and work groups.
  - xiii) Hire Project Facilitator to oversee project.
  - B. Contractor will provide monthly progress reports to Health District based on instructions provided by Health District program staff.

#### Period of Performance: September 30, 2015 – September 29, 2016

- 1. Contractor will increase the number of Clark County School District schools enhancing physical education courses, and offer additional before and after school physical activity opportunities over the duration of the project.
- 2. Contractor's responsibilities include:
  - A. Specific Year 2 Deliverables.
    - i) Expansion of the CF or CFK kids program to five elementary and six middle schools. Schools are selected through the Clark County School District's application process.
    - ii) Provision of support to the 50 existing CF schools.
    - iii) Training of the Year Two teachers in CF Level 1 covering CrossFit and best practices.
    - iv) Teacher certifications for CrossFit Kids teachers covering CrossFit and best practices.
    - v) Instructional supplies for activities that support program expansion.
    - vi) Professional development training for 75 CF certified teachers.
    - vii) Professional development training on incorporating activity breaks for 400 teachers.
    - viii) Implementation of before or after school CF programs in 50 schools.
    - ix) Family Functional Fitness Night events at 50 schools.
    - x) Conduct a CF Showcase event.
    - xi) Maintenance of a CANVAS Student Wellness course aligned to Nevada's School Wellness Policy and CCSD Student Wellness Regulation.
    - xii) Development of an evaluation plan that includes details regarding data collection and analysis, and a final report in collaboration with Health District staff and project evaluators.
    - xiii) Program administration, including attendance of required meetings, involvement in related coalitions and work groups, and supervision of a project facilitator who will be managing the project.
    - B. Contractor will provide monthly progress reports to Health District based on instructions provided by Health District program staff.

#### Period of Performance: September 30, 2016 - September 29, 2017

- 1. CCSD will support CCSD schools enhancing physical education courses, and offer additional before and after school physical activity opportunities over the duration of the project.
- 2. Contractor's responsibilities include:
  - A. The specific Year Three deliverables include:
    - 1) Provide support to ensure ongoing implementation of CrossFit in all 50 participating schools.
    - 2) Ensure ongoing implementation of before or after school CrossFit programs in all 50 participating schools.
    - 3) Support teacher certifications for CrossFit Kids and CrossFit Level certifications (new and re-certifications).
    - 4) Provide professional development training for 75 CrossFit certified teachers.
    - 5) Provide professional development training on incorporating activity breaks for 400 teachers.
    - 6) Implement Family Functional Fitness Night events at 50 schools.
    - 7) Conduct a CrossFit Showcase event.
    - 8) Purchase instructional supplies for activities that support program maintenance and sustainability.
    - 9) Support Implementation of the CCSD Student Wellness Regulation (School Wellness Policy) by facilitating regular meetings of the CCSD Wellness Committee; maintaining the CANVAS Student Wellness online course; and by using various methods (letters, e-mails, automated calls, etc.) to communicate the policy to administrators and parents. Document at least one communication outreach effort to share information about the policy, and resources for how to comply to parents and administrators during the project period.
    - 10) Complete data collection and analysis in accordance with the approved evaluation plan and help develop a final report in collaboration with Health District staff and project evaluators.
    - 11) Provide program administration, including attendance of required meetings, involvement in related coalitions and work groups, and supervision of a project facilitator who will be managing the project.
  - B. Contractor will provide monthly progress reports to Health District based on instructions provided by Health District program staff.

- C. Contractors may not bill more frequently than monthly for the duration of the project. The invoice will detail costs incurred for each item identified in the project budget show in 1.02 above.
  - a. Backup documentation including but not limited to paid invoices, receipts, monthly reports, proof of payments or any other documentation requested by Health District, is required, and shall be submitted by the Contractor in accordance with cost principles applicable to this Agreement.
  - b. Contractor invoices shall be signed by the Contractor's official representative, and shall include a statement certifying that the invoice is a true and accurate billing.

- c. Cost principles contained in the Federal Acquisition Regulation 2 CFR Part 230, Cost Principles for Non-Profit Organizations (OMB Circular A-122), shall be used as criteria in the determination of allowable costs.
- D. Health District shall not be liable for interest charges on late payments.
- E. In the event items on an invoice are disputed, payment on those items will be held until the dispute is resolved.
- F. In order the Health District to close out its fiscal year, Contractor will submit an invoice for all work performed and expenses incurred through June 30, 2017 no later than Friday, July 14, 2017.
- G. In order for the Health District to process grant closeout per grant requirements, Contractor will submit their final invoice to the Health District no later than thirty (30) days after the end of the contract term, or Friday, October 27, 2017.
