SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT DRAFT FUND TYPES


- General Fund used to account for all financial resources except for those required to be accounted for in another fund
- ➤ Special Revenue Funds account for the proceeds of specific revenue sources that are legally restricted to expenditures for specified purposes.
 - Federal Grant Funds Grants directly funded by the Federal Government to the Health District
 - State Grant Funds Grants directly funded by the State of Nevada to the Health District
 - Pass-thru Grant Funds Grants funded by the Federal Government to the State of Nevada, then passed on to the Health District
- Capital Project Funds used to account for financial resources that are restricted, committed or assigned to the improvement, acquisition or construction of capital assets
 - Bond Reserve Fund acquisition or improvements of facilities
 - Capital Projects Fund acquisition of capital assets

FY 2020 BUDGET REVENUE - KEY TAKEAWAYS

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- ► 11% Growth in Projected Revenues over FY2019 Budget
- Property Tax Allocation
 - ▶ \$1M higher than 2018/19 (per Clark County)
- ▶ Charges for Services
 - Clinical Services Insurance charges to increase by \$4.2M driven by Pharmacy service growth, Pharmacy Pricing and increased volume of Patient encounters



FY 2020 BUDGET SPECIAL REVENUE FUND (GRANTS) KEY TAKEAWAYS

- Overall projected increase of \$2.6M, a 17% increase over FY2019 Adopted Budget
- Clinical Services increase by \$1M driven by Grant funding
- ► Community Health increase of \$1.6M projected in Grant Funding
- Environmental Health—No material change from current year



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






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Southern Nevada Health District Expense Comparison by Division Combined General and Special Revenue Funds



SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT EXPENSE COMPARISON BY CATEGORY



- ▶ Category Changes
 - Overall 8% Expenses Growth over FY2019 Budget
 - ▶ Salaries & Fringe increased \$3.1 Million
 - ▶ 4% Salaries Growth over FY2019 Budget
 - Staff adjustments (24 net position increase from current staffing level)
 - ▶ 2.5% Step increase for all eligible staff
 - Services & Supplies increased \$5.6M
 - ► Supplies increased \$2M
 - Contractual increased \$3.4M
 - ► Training/Travel increased \$220K
