



ARTIST CHECKLIST

The following items must be present in your booth prior to inspection by the Southern Nevada Health District

1. Patron consent forms provided by the Event Coordinator must be present and be completed before administering body art
2. Written aftercare instructions provided by the Event Coordinator must be present to be provided after the body art is completed.
3. Sterile equipment properly packaged
4. Tattoo machines clean/good repair/no hazards
5. Disinfecting single-use hand wipes
6. An all-purpose cleaner (such as Tincture of Green Soap) and disinfectant for work surfaces
7. Sharps containers
8. Biohazardous and non-hazardous waste disposal equipment and supplies
9. Non-absorbent chairs, floors, and work surface
10. At least 50 lumens per foot of light in a fixture shielded with a solid barrier or a bulb constructed of shatterproof materials at the level where the body art work is being applied
11. If using non-disposable instruments, a copy of spore test conducted within 7 days of the event.
