EMS-RN CHECKLIST

Note: EMS-RNs must submit all of the following online via the EMS Portal to the EMSTS Office prior to scheduling to take the ALS Licensure examination. All online provider courses <u>must</u> include verifiable documentation of skills.

 - > All procedures as listed on the "Physician Advisor Verification of EMS RN Skills"
 - > All procedures as listed on the "Skills Proficiency Record"

After receipt of the above, the EMS-RN may contact the EMSTS office to schedule to take the ALS Licensure examination. The EMS-RN has three attempts to pass the exam. Applicants requesting a fourth attempt must submit to the OEMSTS, at a minimum, written documentation from the applicant's sponsoring agency of successful completion of remedial training on the Clark County Emergency Care Protocols. A maximum of six attempts will be allowed, after which time he/she must wait one year from the last attempt to reapply.

If the EMS-RN passes the ALS Licensure examination with a score of 80% or higher, the EMS-RN will be asked to take a photo for an "Endorsement" card allowing him/her to function as an EMS-RN in Clark County.
