REPLICA IMPLEMENTATION

Beginning October 1, 2023, the REPLICA Compact will be implemented in the State of Nevada. The following is intended to guide applicants who are seeking recognition as an EMS provider in Clark County, NV. The Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) regulates EMS in Clark County, Nevada and the processes used in Clark County may differ from the state. 1. The licensure compact applies to individuals only, not agencies.
2. The SNHD District Health Officer, via authority granted by Nevada Revised Statute and EMS Regulations, provides ultimate medical direction for all EMS providers in Clark County.
3. As the medical direction authority, SNHD is allowed by REPLICA to include additional requirements for licensure. These items include but may not be limited to.
 - a. Submission of application, including current provider cards and mandatory training as specified in Regulation,
 - b. Letter of intent by a permitted ambulance service indicating the individual will be employed as a licensed provider,
 - c. Submission of fingerprints,
 - d. Successful completion of the protocol examination.
4. There is no change to the current process for out of state wildland fire assets working in Clark County.
5. Franchise and municipal codes restricting ambulance services are not superseded.
