List of Changes for the January 2025 protocol update:

- 1. Removal of Phenylephrine from Pulmonary Edema protocol. Addition of Push Dose Epinephrine to the Pulmonary Edema protocol. Formulary for both Push Dose Epinephrine and Phenylephrine updated to reflect this change.
- 2. Addition of Tranexamic Acid to Hemorrhage Control Protocol and Formulary.
- Updating of the Adult Stable Tachycardia and Adult Unstable Tachycardia protocols to direct providers to the Electrical Therapy/Cardioversion and Electrical Therapy/Transcutaneous Pacing procedures protocols for sedation and analgesia medications and dosages.
- 4. Updates to the Adult Allergic Reaction protocol including definitions of allergic reaction and anaphylaxis.
- 5. Updates to the Pediatric Allergic Reaction protocol including definitions of allergic reaction and anaphylaxis and change on the dose of diphenhydramine to 1 mg/kg for all routes.
- 6. Creation of a Patient Restraints Operations protocol.
- 7. Change in the scope of practice to allow EMTs to administer Acetaminophen PO. Reflected in both Adult and Pediatric Pain Management protocols.
- 8. Change in the scope of practice to allow AEMTs to administer Acetaminophen IV, IO, and PO. Reflected in both the Adult and Pediatric Pain Management protocols.
- 9. Dose of Acetaminophen PO on Adult Pain Management protocol to read: 325 mg to 1 g PO.
- 10. Maximum dose added to Acetaminophen PO on Pediatric Pain Management to read: maximum single dose 1 g.
- 11. Repeat dosing for Morphine in adult patients changed to read: "May repeat after 10 minutes". Reflected in Adult Pain Management, Electrical Therapy: Synchronized Cardioversion, and Electrical Therapy: Transcutaneous Pacing protocols.
- 12. Removal of Etomidate from the Electrical Therapy: Transcutaneous Pacing protocol.
