Summary of Changes for 2024 EMS Procedure Manual

- 1. Updated current staff listing
- 2. Clarification that all initial education requests must include the submission of a course lesson plan with course hours, course syllabus, and Instructor names.
- 3. Clarification that course rosters must be submitted within 10 days of the beginning of the course.
- 4. Course completion information including the name of the attendee and date of attendance for continuing education classes must be uploaded via the portal into the EMS training record once the training has been completed.
- 5. Removal of the requirement for National Registry psychomotor examinations at the AEMT and Paramedic level since these examinations are no longer required by National Registry.
- 6. Rural volunteers will have documentation of the service they are authorized with and their expiration date documented in their provider file once their authorization is completed.
- 7. Paramedics must obtain National Registry at the paramedic level to be eligible for the renewal of an expired Nevada certificate.
- 8. Removal of the requirement of provisional licensure for paramedics certified in Clark County who have not been licensed in the last 12 months.
- 9. Clarification that if a provisional paramedic changes sponsoring agencies during their internship, a new provisional license with the new sponsoring agency must be issued. The issue and expiration dates on the new license will be the same as the original issued provisional license.
- 10. Restructuring of Critical Care Paramedic internship, removing the required 120 hours and moving to a specified skills-based format.
- 11. Clarification that EMS Instructor II applicants need only supply the didactic monitoring form if they are a currently endorsed EMS Instructor I. If they are not currently an endorsed EMS Instructor, they must completed both the skills and the didactic portion of the monitoring form.
- 12. Addition of prerequisites for Master EMS Instructor.
- 13. Removal of the 4 hour Instructor update from the EMS Instructor challenge process.
- 14. Clarification that only participating agencies may sponsor a candidate for EMT-IV endorsement.
- 15. Clarification that any continuing education hours for instructor development will be credited towards the applicant's hourly recertification requirements.
- 16. Addition of West Henderson Hospital to the South Region for Internal Disaster rotation in periods when multiple hospitals need to utilize Internal Disaster.
- 17. Addition of an OEMSTS Examination Policy.
