WHY?



WHY?



WHY?




CURRENT BURDEN?

U.S. News Report and World Report put Nevada at #31 in the U.S. for health care. This ranking averages indicators such as Nevada being #44 for health care access, but #18 for health care quality. While ranking so low for health care access is not ideal, it is encouraging that when people do receive care it is of a high standard.

REPORT FINDINGS

- Clark County is largely behind on health metrics.
- Individuals living in the northeast metropolitan area, as well as more rural areas in the south and north in Clark County have on average lower median incomes, higher poverty percentages, and fewer health checkups to their primary care doctors.
- The main ZIP codes affected were 89025, 89046, 89039, 89030, 89101, and 89115.

REPORT FINDINGS

- Black/ African Americans had higher rates of insurance coverage and higher high school completion, but were more likely to experience preventable hospital stays, lower math proficiency, and lower household incomes.
- The 'Other' racial category often had poorer outcomes for our selected indicators. We may be missing this population in more ways than one- both in capturing this group's racial identity and in supporting them through the identified health issues.

ECONOMY

- Nevada HAND is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that serves over 8,000 lowincome individuals with 35 communities of affordable rental housing (income restrictions apply).
- Nevada HAND offers both family and senior (age 55+) apartment communities enhanced by Resident Services to support better health and wellness outcomes, educational attainment, community engagement, and financial stability.




EDUCATION




- The Children's Cabinet offers Community
 Education Classes and trainings for
 parents including Safe Sleep for Infants,
 Car Seat Safety, VROOM activities for
 parents to stimulate learning for their young
 children, and classes to help prepare for
 the transition to kindergarten.
- They provide Early Childhood Community Health Workers which support over 15,000 families throughout the state of Nevada.

HEALTH CARE ACCESS

- Puentes is a nonprofit community-based organization focused on reducing systemic and structural inequity though the development of sustainable support and services which improve the social determinants of health in the communities they serve.
- In 2022, Puentes conducted 785 outreach events within vulnerable communities.
 These events varied from pop-ups, to
 Greet, Eat and Meet (GEM) events, to full resource fairs that included vaccinations and other medical support.




Health Equity Status Report

The Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) has released its inaugural Health Equity Status Report, focusing on key health indicators in terms of Economic Stability, Education Access and Quality, and Health Care Access and Quality. The report outlines social determinants of health and how they relate to Clark County and Healthy People 2030, a 10-year plan for improving the health and well-being of people in the United States. The report also highlights work being done in Southern Nevada to reduce health disparities. The report uses data by ZIP code, race/ethnicity, age and gender to inform community members and organizations about key health indicators affecting Southern Nevadans. In doing so, SNHD aims to empower Clark County residents to better understand local health issues and what is being done about them.

Along with the Health Equity Status Report, we have created this document to increase the accessibility of our report.
