Flesch-Kincaid Readability Score Calculator	Readable	Shows how readable your text is by providing a Flesch Readability Ease Score and Flesch-Kincaid Grade Level Score.
Simple Measure of Gobbledygook (SMOG) Readability Test	Readability	Estimates the level of education needed to understand a piece of writing.
