#### I. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

The Regional Trauma Advisory Board (RTAB) convened in the Red Rock Trail Conference Room at the Southern Nevada Health District, located at 280 S. Decatur Boulevard, on July 19, 2023. If anyone is interested in joining in on this endeavor, she welcomes that. She will also bring information to the RTAB in order to collaborate and possibly put some programs together.
