

Public Health Advisory 10/02/2024 Bicillin ® L-A Supply Shortage and Syphilis Treatment

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS SUMMARY

Situation: On September 24, 2024, the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health released a technical bulletin regarding the <u>Bicillin® supply</u>.

- Bicillin® L-A (penicillin G benzathine) is the recommended treatment for syphilis, and the only recommended treatment for pregnant persons diagnosed with or exposed to active syphilis.
- SNHD is in communication with local providers with high utilization of Bicillin® L-A and can confirm that there is sufficient supply of Bicillin® in Clark County.
- While current supplies are sufficient, the manufacturer anticipates full <u>availability</u> by the end
 of the year.

Recommendations for providers:

✓ Treat with Bicillin® L-A for all appropriate cases

- <u>CDC Syphilis Treatment Guidelines</u> help with staging and management considerations.
- Bicillin® C-R is not an acceptable alternative.
