SIZE:

This facility, as proposed, will consist of approximately 89,090 square feet in area (30,160 square feet interior). The maximum storage capacity is approximately 3,000 cubic yards. The maximum processing rate is approximately 720 cubic yards per day.

OPERATIONS:

This facility is seeking a permit from the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) to operate a recycling center. A recycling center includes a facility designed and operated to receive, store, or process recyclable materials which have been separated at the source of waste generation from other solid waste and for which there is an available market. This facility will accept Metals (Non-ferrous scrap metals); catalytic converter ceramic bricks and oxygen sensors. Cardboard and wood pallets, associated with the metals, catalytic converters and oxygen sensors will also be recycled. This facility will NOT be open to the public. There will be no outdoor processing or operations.
